STORM DAMAGE - IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM INSURANCE IRELAND

Insurance Ireland has issued advice to householders about what to do if they suffer storm damage to their property.

- Household buildings and contents insurance policies cover damage caused by storms.
- Damage to cars is covered by comprehensive motor insurance policies.
- Insurers will usually pay for the cost of temporary repairs, so please keep receipts.
- Insurers will also usually pay for the cost of alternative accommodation, up to policy limits, if the home becomes uninhabitable.
- Householders should check the full extent of their policies and contact their insurer or broker for further advice if needed.
